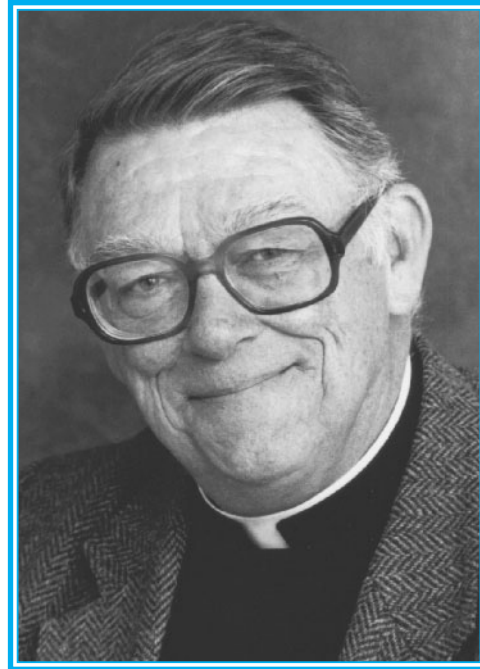

Since its inception, Share Foundation has always been a Christian organization. Even though our founder, Father Blaney, is a catholic priest, the organization is not directly affiliated with any particular religion, but embraces and follows Christian values. Our services are provided to other abled people regardless to religious affiliation and our camps are values retreats centered around discussing and practicing Christian morals.

While we're not affiliated with any certain religion, many churches throughout northwest Indiana have been supportive of our work. When we conducted our capital campaign a few years ago, the Diocese of Gary made a sizeable pledge as well as many individual churches in the diocese that also pledged their support. Many Protestant churches also contributed to the campaign and some have made regular contributions to our mission, realizing as we do, that disability knows no boundaries and that we're all brothers and sisters in Christ.

In addition to financial support, churches have also helped us recruit volunteers and publicize our fundraising events. More importantly, they have prayed for us and asked God to continue to bless our work.

Recently I became aware of a unique group of Christians who have joined together to practice Christian values in an innovative way. A group of people from several churches of different religions in Chesterton is operating the United Churches Resale Shop. They accept donations of gently used clothing, toys, books and household furnishings for sale in their resale shop. The shop is staffed entirely by volunteers and 100% of the profits are given away to a wide variety of charities! These people practice their Christianity by taking items someone no longer needs and turning them into cash to fund organizations who are making a difference in the lives of the people they serve. What a heartwarming example of living your faith!

Their shop is bright and cheerful. The volunteers who staff it greet each visitor with a smile and kind words. As I looked through the items offered for sale, I was impressed by the sense of unity that was prevalent. One person was putting price tags on items, another was sorting clothes by size and yet another was re-arranging shelves to make room for newly arrived merchandise. They were members of different churches practicing their faith by doing God's work together.

Share Foundation has been blessed to receive a share of the profits from the United Churches Resale Shop on two different occasions. We are grateful to them for their generosity and we are also happy to be associated with such an admirable group of people. May God continue to bless the Christians who operate the United Churches Resale Shop and may they serve as an example to others!

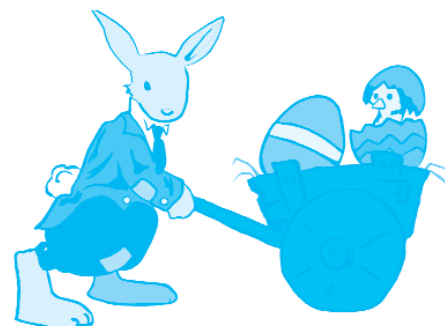

*The Circle of Sharing Society** is a way for Share Foundation to secure the future of Sharing Meadows by articulating our plan for growth while also recognizing the vital part that donations play, regardless of the amount, in helping us to realize the full potential of our strategic plan.

Sharing Meadows has reached full capacity; there are no more spaces available for other abled adults who would like to become residents in our peaceful community—and yet, our waiting list keeps getting longer and longer. There are so many other abled adults who need to know that one day they can call Sharing Meadows home. The individuals on our waiting list and their families deserve to know that when they come knocking, there will be room at the inn. That said, we must gear up to build new villages so that we can accommodate those who seek permanent placement and refuge at Sharing Meadows. Through your support of *The Circle of Sharing Society*, a new village will be a reality in 2004!

We must also be mindful of the many programs that already exist at Sharing Meadows, including the residential program, monthly mini-camps, summer camp, and vocational training. In order to maintain these programs that are so vital to the Villagers' development and progress toward self-sufficiency, it is our responsibility to continually update activities in order to keep the Villagers mentally and physically stimulated. Again, contributions made to *The Circle of Sharing Society* will allow us to build an endowment fund that will protect the future of Sharing Meadows for generations to come. When you make a donation that is earmarked for the endowment, the principle amount of your gift will never be touched; however, the earned interest will be used to meet the daily necessities of operating the villages at Sharing Meadows.

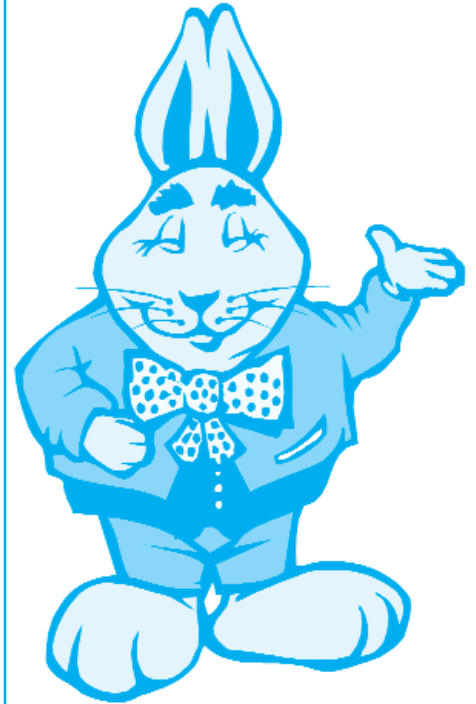
