BEHIND THE SCENES AT CAMP SHARING MEADOWS

The success of Camp Sharing Meadows can be attributed to the spirited campers as much as the dedicated staff. Although a new set of campers came in and out of Sharing Meadows over the five weeks, many of the staff dedicated more than one week of their time and love to making camp a pleasant experience for the campers. The nurses, the cooks, the craft director, the teacher, the camp director and each of the counselors gave camp a distinct, upbeat atmosphere. The following paragraphs might give you a glimpse of some of the people behind the camp.

Although camp can be stressful for all of the staff, the woman responsible for planning events and activities overcame many challenges with a smile. This was camp director Natalie Missaggia's third summer at Camp Sharing Meadows, but first experience as director. To Natalie it is the camper's smiling faces at the end of each week that makes camp worthwhile. Her experiences at camp have reinforced Natalie's decision to become a special education major and lead to a life long goal of improving the special education system. "Everyone has the right and ability to learn. I want to make education possible for everyone," she said. Natalie's background and acceptance of all people made her an excellent camp director.

Getting to know the campers from a whole different perspective, camp nurse Helen Hathoot has served at Camp Sharing Meadows for around 7 years. Although the specifics of the camp nurse position did not allow for Helen to get to know the campers in the same manner that their counselors experienced, she got to know the campers on a physiological level by administering medication and solving a variety of personal problems. Helen saw each of the 25 campers several times a day allowing her to experience camp on a broad level. The camp nurse provided an essential service for the safety and comfort of all the campers as well as the staff.

Looking to serve others and gain experience, Ky Bertoli chose Camp Sharing Meadows as his summer service project through Notre Dame's Center for Social Concerns. He devoted his entire summer to Sharing Meadows by serving as teacher for all five weeks of camp, creating lessons and leading group discussions every morning centered around the theme "God Will Provide for All of Our Needs." During these open discussions Ky felt that he learned a lot from the campers. Everyone shared their personal experiences and many felt comfortable approaching him after the session for further conversation. By serving as teacher, Ky contributed to the spiritual element of camp that made it more meaningful to the campers.

Once upon a time there was a young couple, let's call them the Howards, who had two young children and a modest life. Over the course of their lifetimes, the Howards worked hard to make an honest living and educate their children. They are now happily retired and find themselves thinking about reorganizing their finances and lifestyle to suit their empty nest. Advice given to the Howards by a financial planner with regard to their life insurance policies is the same advice we would like to pass along to you. A careful review of their finances helped the Howards realize that they no longer needed to carry the amount of life insurance that they did when they had younger, dependent children. Their solution: donate their fully paid-up policy to the Share Foundation.

By making a donation of their policy to the Share Foundation, the Howards were entitled to a charitable deduction equal to the lesser of the premiums they paid over the life of the policy or the cost of a comparable replacement policy if purchased today.

Making a charity the beneficiary of a life insurance policy is one way supporters can make a sizeable future gift to the charity of their choice. By simply naming Share Foundation, for instance, as the beneficiary of your policy, you retain lifetime ownership of the policy which means that you retain the right to cash it in, borrow against it, or even change the beneficiary. Because your gift is a contribution that will actually be made in the future, policy owners are not eligible for charitable deductions on premium payments made during their lifetime; however, because the policy's proceeds will be included in your gross estate, your estate will be able to take an estate tax charitable deduction.

It turns out that the Howard children were also supportive of the idea and the oldest child even purchased a small whole life policy and designated Share Foundation as the owner and irrevocable beneficiary. As a result, the annual premiums that are paid become a charitable deduction!

Over the next few months, we will address many frequently asked questions about making a gift of a life insurance policy and creating life insurance trusts. We will also keep you informed of the possibilities a gift of this nature can provide for you and your family while also continuing to ensure and support the dream of Sharing Meadows.
