Mary did a fine job raising Joe. She did a fine job working on behalf of the other abled. She made a difference! May God welcome her!

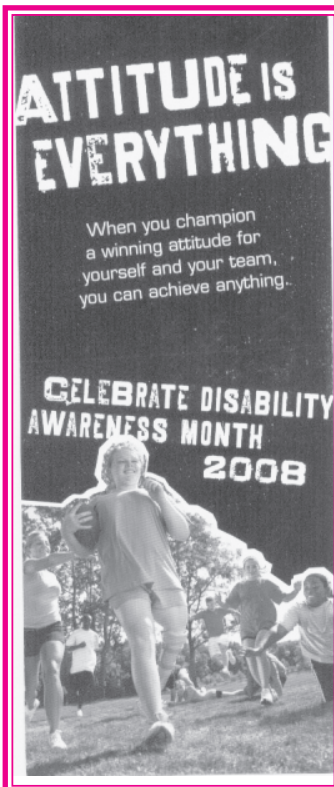
For the villager's vocational training, they are divided into crews with each crew responsible for one aspect of the work day. Our work coordinators, Dolores and Donna, assign each villager to a crew based on their skill level and area of interest. Time of year has a great deal to do with what the daily activities will be with a lot of indoor work being done in the winter and lots of ground maintenance accomplished during the spring and summer. Sometimes a villager will request a certain crew and the work coordinators make every effort to accommodate their requests.

Last summer one of the lady villagers asked to be on the mowing crew. She is petite with a thin build so the supervisors were a bit concerned that she wouldn't have the strength and stamina necessary to get the job done. She insisted she wanted to do it so she was trained on safe use of the equipment and off she went to join the mowing crew. Well, her job performance was amazing! She approached the task with determination and confidence as she handled the weed whacker, pushed a lawn mower and got the job done! She was an asset to the mowing crew and the others welcomed her help and participation.

I was reminded of this story when I received materials from the Indiana Governor's Council for People With Disabilities in celebration of Disabilities Awareness Month in March. The theme this year is **Attitude is Everything**. The poster shows a group of young people on a playing field and the girl in the center, who is holding a football, has an artificial leg. A smaller picture beneath shows her carrying the football with confidence and determination as she makes her way to the goal. The poster goes on to say, "To be a champion, you have to think like one. On and off the field, you have to know that the only thing that can stop you.....is you. And when you champion a winning attitude for yourself and your team, you can achieve anything."

The poster was made to increase awareness of disabilities among the public but it's very typical of life here at Sharing Meadows. Our villagers know that they aren't DISABLED, they're OTHER ABLED and they use their abilities with self assurance, tenacity and resolve to champion a winning attitude for themselves and their team. They know they can achieve anything and it is gratifying to watch them put their hearts and souls into everything they do.

March may be the month that's officially designated as "Disabilities Awareness" but at Sharing Meadows, we celebrate and give thanks for each other's abilities each and every day. Our realization that attitude is everything gives us a winning team.

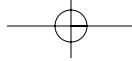
