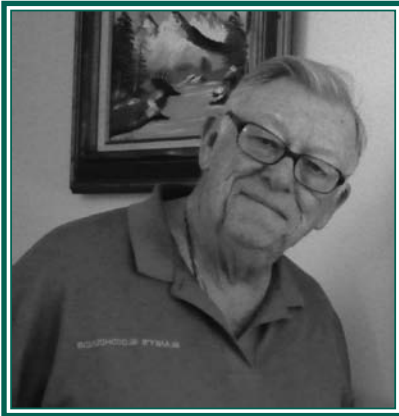

## HOW ABOUT YOU?

How about you? Have you made some progress in updating, reviewing or making an estate plan? It is important for you to remember that you are making things a lot easier for your loved ones by having a properly prepared estate plan handled by the person(s) you want to carry out your wishes. Without this, you will die intestate and the laws of the State in which you reside will say who gets what share of your Estate. Worse yet, your Estate may be handled by someone that you would not want to have that responsibility. This would come about because you failed to plan properly.

In our last discussion, we addressed Wills and explained a little about them in the limited space available to us. Today, we are going to address an entirely different type of estate planning tool, a Revocable Living Trust, "RLT". There are many types of trusts, testamentary, irrevocable, irrevocable life insurance, special needs, land trusts, etc. However, we are only going to concentrate on RLTs this month. You will see there is a dramatic difference between RLTs and a Will.

Many people think that trusts are complicated and they are only for the very rich. Nothing could be further from the truth. Trusts can benefit many people, whether you have large estates or not. However, not everyone needs a trust. We will discuss the criteria for that in another article where we put all of our ideas together.

Very simply, a RLT is a form of a written contract between two parties, the Trustor(s) (who own the assets) and the Trustee(s) (who take legal title to the assets). The Trustor(s) transfer the assets to the Trustee (this is called "funding") and the Trustee manages the assets according to the terms of the Trust Agreement. In the past, it was not uncommon to name a bank to serve as Trustee. Today, however, it is much more common to name an individual to serve as Trustee. In fact, by far the greatest percentage of time, the Trustor(s) serve as Trustee and manages the assets for the benefit of the Beneficiaries, who are the same person(s) as the Trustor(s) and Trustee(s). They are all one and the same person(s). This is called a "Grantor Trust" and has significant advantages when it comes to taxing the trust. The RLT is a grantor trust, and the individuals who created the trust do not have to file any new income tax returns. They still file the same income tax returns they have always filed. Basically, this is the type of RLT you should consider, whether you are married or single.

The only difference for you is that most of your assets are titled in your name as "Trustee". However, whatever you could have done before you transferred your assets into your name as Trustee, you can do the same things afterward. There are no restrictions on what you can do, except those that you have created in your Trust. There are some assets you do not transfer the ownership into your Trust, they are IRAs, 401(k)s, 403(b)s, or other pension plans, annuities and life insurance policies. These are all transferred by the designation you make as to who the beneficiaries of each of them are to be.

Why should you consider using a RLT? First, if you are married and one of you becomes incapacitated, the other one continues to act. You can avoid a Guardianship of your affairs this way. If you are single (or the surviving Spouse) and become incapacitated, your RLT names a successor trustee to take over to handle your affairs. Again, you avoid a Guardianship to handle your affairs. Guardianships are overseen by the Courts. As a result, you avoid Court involvement while you are alive. This is to be contrasted with a Will, which does absolutely nothing to avoid a Guardianship because it only becomes effective when you die and it is admitted to probate in Court.

Second, you avoid probate. A RLT is a contract that continues on in existence after your death. There is no need to invoke the jurisdiction of the Court to oversee the management of the RLT. The Trustee, with the assistance of a qualified attorney, oversees the administration of the Trust. Remember, all assets are in the RLT, or there are beneficiary designations on those assets that are not in the RLT. As a result, generally speaking a trust administration can be handled more quickly, efficiently, and less expensively than a probate proceeding.

The most difficult decision you face in using a RLT is not in deciding who gets what, or when they get it (at what age, etc.), but who handles the RLT when you are no longer able to do so. If you are married, of course your Spouse serves, but what happens if he/she becomes incapacitated too, or when they are the survivor. You need to give serious consideration as to whom you are naming as Successor Trustee. In a number of instances, it can be, or should be, a bank. Don't just name your oldest child.

Again, if you are married, your Spouse cannot be disinherited. Anyone else can be, however. You use the same concept we discussed in our Wills discussion. Upon the death of your Spouse, or if you're single, you can leave your assets to whomever you want, in what proportion you want. That decision is up to you. Remember to provide what happens to the share of a beneficiary that dies before you do.

You can also make specific distributions of any amount, to anyone you want, including a charity. You can create a Special Needs Trust for your Child who lives at Share. We'll explain these trusts later. If you have a Child at Share, you should certainly think of providing for them when you are no longer here. If you do not have a Child at Share, remember Share is all privately funded and anything that they may receive from any of you will be put to very good use, as you well know.
